

Canipus, in the time it takes to read this

The stall that comes to you. Companies post their films and photographs for your specialty and your city; you watch them when you have two minutes, check any device against the registers, ask the company the price or the evidence with your name on it, and send the one you want to your hospital's purchase desk. All of it is free for a doctor, and your number stays yours.

WHAT IT COSTS YOU

- **Nothing.** The feed, the films, saving and following, every check, every question, the desk, the wire, your numbers. A doctor never pays and never sees a price.
- **The company pays** Canipus a few credits to answer you, and never a share of any sale.
- **A paid place** in the feed says so on the card. Nothing else is ever paid for.

WHAT A COMPANY SEES

- How many doctors of a specialty in a city watched, found useful, followed, checked, read its line. **Never who.**
- Your name and specialty **only when you write to it.**
- Never your number, never your conversations with another company, never what you saved.

HOW TO START

- Sign in at canipus.com with your email. Five answers, once: who you are, your specialty, what you care about, where you practise, your proof.
- Your proof is your registration number, checked against the register; for a student, a photograph of the college ID, seen by a person within a day.
- Home is then the map. Start at 2 · Films and photos, or type a device into Check it.
